GUIDING PRINCIPLES:

Be Safe

- Keep hands, feet, body, and objects to self
- Walk quietly and quickly
- Use equipment properly

Be Respectful

- Listen carefully to directions the first time
- Follow the directions of all adults
- Play fairly, be helpful, and include others

Be Responsible

- Ask for help when needed
- Be aware of others around you
- Solve conflicts using problem-solving skills
- Take care of people and property

Consequences:

- 1. Correct the action; "Make it Right" - mediation, counseling, call to Parents*
- 2. Lose privileges - Parent meeting—project, detention, other as determined by Principal/Parent*
- 3. In-school suspension*
- 4. Out-of-school suspension*
