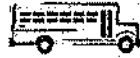


The Tiger's Rules

Place a check next to the rule as you go over each one.

On the School Bus, I will:

- 1. Stay seated at all times.
- 2. Keep my head and hands inside.
- 3. Talk quietly and behave.
- 4. Use appropriate language.
- 5. Keep my bus clean.
- 6. Not eat or drink.
- 7. Always listen and be respectful to the bus driver.



In the Cafeteria, I will . . .

- 1. Wait quietly in line.
- 2. Stay seated.
- 3. Use my inside voice.
- 4. Use good table manners.
- 5. Keep the cafeteria clean.
- 6. Listen and show respect to the adults in charge.



On the Bicycle, I will follow the rules of the road and . . .

- 1. Wear my helmet at all times.
- 2. Cross with the Crossing Guard.
- 3. Walk my bicycle on school grounds.



At Recess time, I will . . .

- 1. Stay in the playground area.
- 2. Use the equipment safely.
- 3. Not throw rocks or sand.
- 4. Play in a safe way with others.
- 5. Come when called.
- 6. Respect the rights of others.
- 7. Include everyone who wants to play.
- 8. Report any problem to the adult in charge.



As a Walker, I will . . .

- 1. Always walk on the sidewalk.
- 2. NOT walk between buses and cars.
- 3. Cross with the Crossing Guard.
- 4. Look both ways when crossing.
- 5. Respect the property of others.
- 6. GO DIRECTLY HOME and always STAY AWAY from STRANGERS!



As a General Rule, I will . . .

- 1. Be responsible for what I do and say.
- 2. Respect my teachers, staff, others, and myself.
- 3. Respect all school property.
- 4. Follow classroom rules.
- 5. Wear appropriate clothing in school.
- 6. Not wear hats in the school building.
- 7. Not bring electronic devices or trading cards to school.

Tiger's Rules for Parents

- 1. Call the Nurse when your child is absent.
- 2. Send in a note following your child's absence.
- 3. Check your child's homework for completion.
- 4. Call your child's teacher if you have a concern.
- 5. Assist your child in arriving at school on time every day that your child is not sick.
- 6. Be on time to pick up your child at the assigned location.
- 7. Make every attempt to attend conference appointments.
