Name	Comment
Maria Martello Angelo	Implored the Board to reconsider closing Bellerose Avenue and Dickinson Avenue Schools. Asked to pause it for a year so the kids can go back to being kids.
James Connor	Stated that it is extremely premature and dangerous to bring students back to school and asked the Board to follow through on their commitment to the health and safety of each student.
Craig Mooers	Asked the Board to come up with a plan to have extracurricular activities and clubs be in person for students.
Michelle Coggins	Asked the Board to pause the closing of Bellerose Avenue and Dickinson Avenue Schools. It is not the right time to close schools and it is creating chaos instead of stability.
Nicholas and Donna Cardascia	Asked the Board to consider a third option to allow students who are currently hybrid to maintain that model at least until April when more teachers will be vaccinated and windows can be opened.
Christina Karman	Stated that the Bellerose Avenue and Dickinson Avenue students are the only students affected by the closing of schools. There are unanswered questions and the educational impact study should have been done already. The solution is not closing schools.
Lisa Cellura	Thanked the Board for listening to the science, data and the community. There is no reason for any instructional day to end at 12:25 and there needs to be a change to the remote full day on Wednesdays.
Leigh Boodoo	Stated that the SEPTA board wanted to let the district know that they are there to support any parents who have IEP questions or any concerns.
Halle Brenner Perles	Implored the Board to reconsider the plans to reopen the schools to full in-person learning. The new variants are highly contagious and social distancing less than 6' is high risk and unacceptable. There are valid

concerns based on science and data. Asked what plans are in place to let remote students to be able to participate better.

- Carrie DeWan Stated that there is an abundance of evidence in the medical community and it defied explanation that the school would rush to reopen. More time is needed to adequately phase in full in-person model. The new remote model has not been detailed, potentially denying students an equitable education.
- Denise Schwartz Stated that there is science, data and experience that concludes having students full time in-person is safe. The district uses plexi-glass and masks in the classrooms. We are using three protocols and only need to use two. We need to find the balance between being scared and living lives on a cautious level.

There was a discussion regarding contact tracing, class sizes, additional staffing needs, 6' social distancing and 3.5' social distancing with barriers, and livestreaming.
